Here you have the wh questions words. We use question words to ask certain types of questions. We often refer to them as WH words because they include the letters WH (for example WHy, HoW).



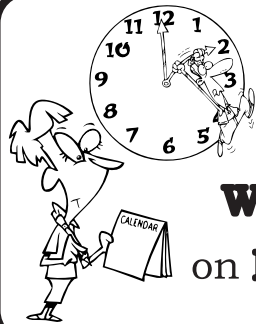

It is in my **bag** in my **house**.

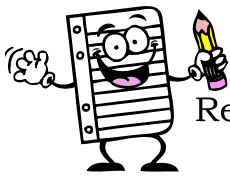

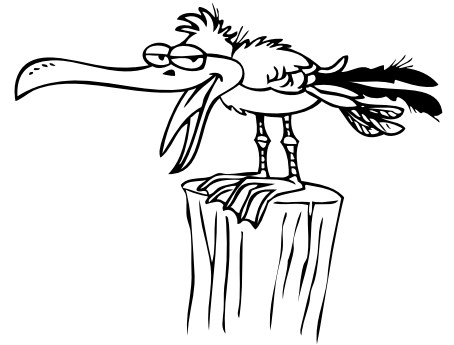
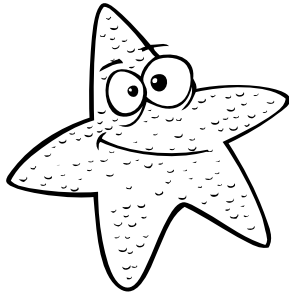
